The current open Committee Chair positions are:

Web Committee – We need 2 more people to work on this committee. At present, Dale Mickey has kindly agreed to remain in this role for another school year. Each week, the HOP website is populated with important information through weekly notices. In this position, you will receive weekly notices that will be submitted to you by people who would like to have information posted to the HOP website. You will prepare the notices for posting and forward them to the Webmaster.

1st Grade Craft Center - Coordinate craft projects, teachers and parents so that the first graders can create wonderful crafts that support the first grade curriculum.

Festivals Coordinator - Work with the teachers and school principal to ensure that the grade-level festivals support the curricula and remain enjoyable programs for K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 5th grades. In this role, you will also work with parents to staff the Co-Chair positions for each festival.

Fifth Grade Activities Coordinator - Work with the school principal, 5th grade teachers, 5th graders and their parents to coordinate, staff and manage a number of fundraisers, leadership opportunities and festivities to commemorate the 5th graders' last year at Haynes.

School Committee Observer – In this role, you will attend School Committee Meetings, which are held every other week (usually on Wednesday evenings) and report information to the HOP Board and parents as needed. This is a great opportunity to interface with the SPS District leaders.

Parent Education Programs - Work with a small group of parents from the other Sudbury Public Schools (SPS) in order to facilitate the hiring of a well-known author, who will make a parenting-related presentation to all interested SPS parents.

Science Enrichment Committee Chairs - This is a great opportunity for 2 people. You will work with the school principal and teachers to bring science-related programs to the individual grades and to the whole school. In this role, you will meet with teachers to understand what types of programs are needed, what has worked in the past and what new ones could be researched and introduced. You will be responsible for hiring the vendors and facilitating their visits to Haynes.

Science Fair Co-Chairs - We are looking for 2 or 3 people to Co-chair the increasingly popular annual Haynes Science Fair. The Science Fair will be in its 4th year in the 2008-2009 school year. It has been an event that students, parents, teachers, and the school and district administrations have participated in and really enjoyed. It truly is a wonderful testament to the dedication of our parent volunteers. This one program, that brings the whole Haynes community together, has become one of the most anticipated events of our school year!
